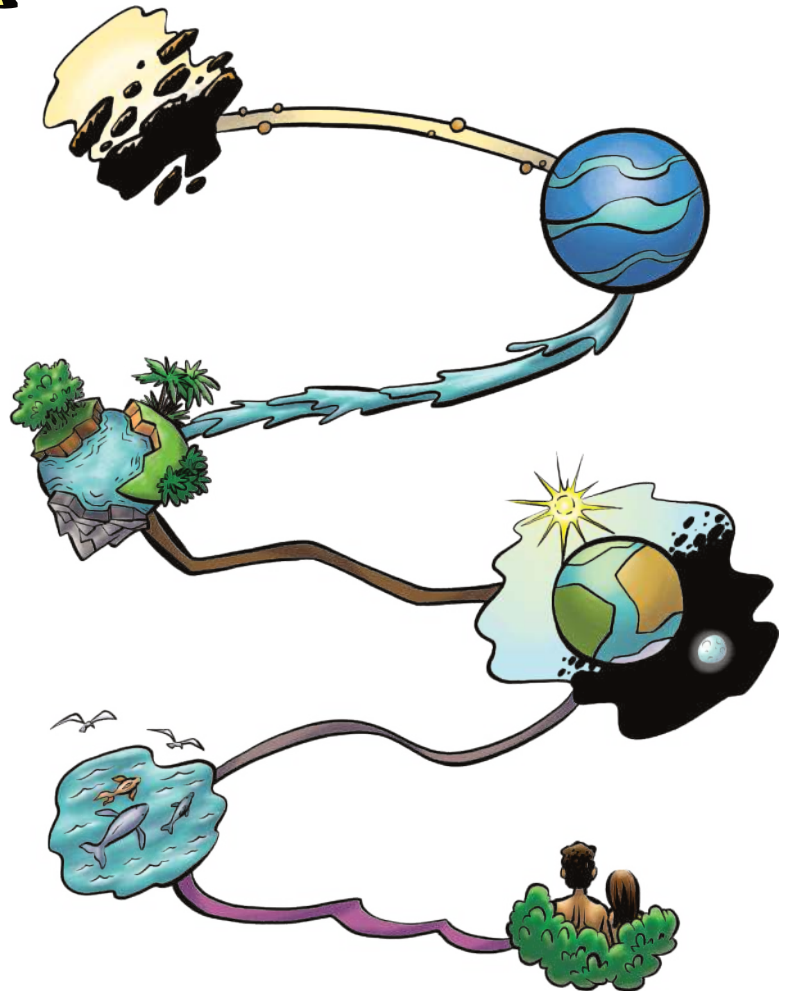

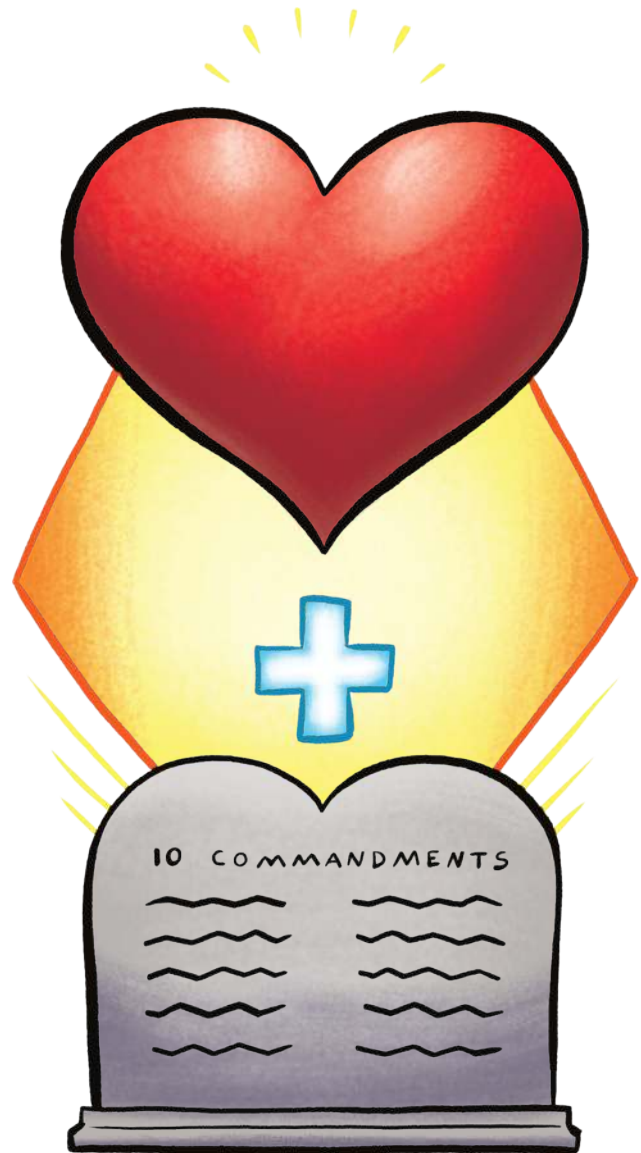

By loving Him and doing what He commands.



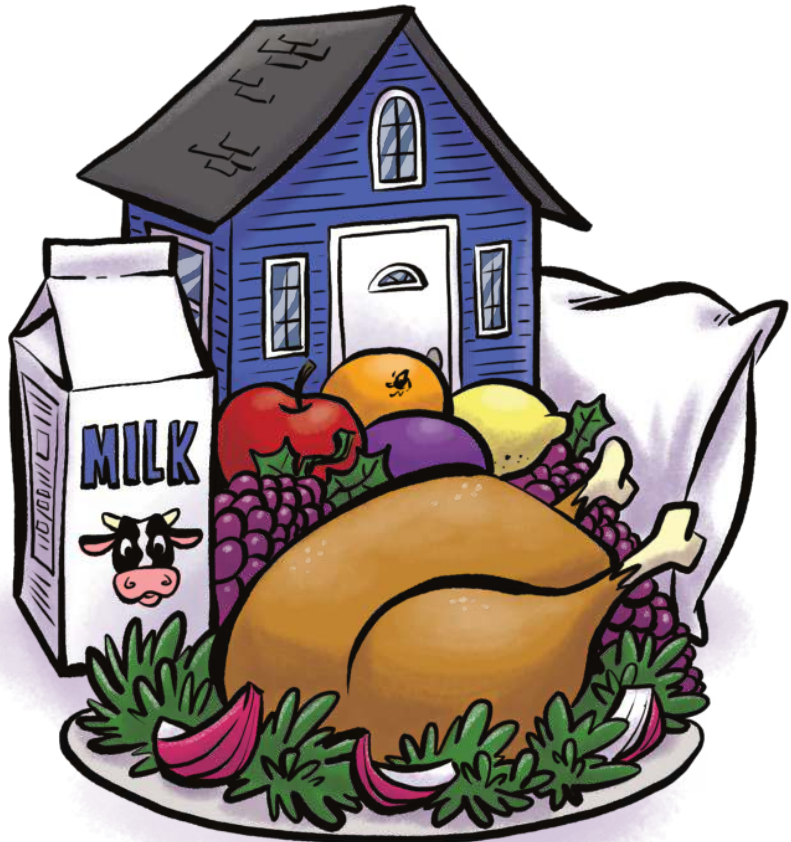
